Dear parents,

With the re-equilibration of the economy on 24th June, it has become increasingly apparent that we would be unable to recruit and be able to offer competitive forex salaries to the five French-speaking teachers that would be required to deliver the French programme starting September 2019.

This was confirmed in a meeting that we had with the Deputy Ambassador on the 8th July. At this meeting, he made it perfectly clear that the embassy would in no way assist with the setting up of this programme. Indeed, he went further stating quite clearly, that the embassy would do everything in its power to frustrate any attempt that the College might make to initiate this programme.

We entered into this whole process in good faith but now must accept, that for the time being, St George's College will not be able to offer the French programme. We apologise for the inconvenience and raised expectations that this may have caused but the outcome has been determined by forces beyond our control.
